



TOWN OF MACGREGOR

BY-LAW NO: 771-2011

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF MACGREGOR TO ESTABLISH A RATE FOR THE PROVISION OF POLICE PROTECTION WHICH INCLUDES 911 SERVICES AS A SPECIAL SERVICE WITHIN THE TOWN OF MACGREGOR FOR 2011 TO 2013, INCLUSIVE.

WHEREAS Section 312 of The Municipal Act of Manitoba, provides in part as follows:

312 If approved by by-law, a municipality may provide, as a special service to all or part of the municipality, one or more of the following:

- i) fire and police protection services;

AND WHEREAS subsection 320(1) of the Act provides as follows:

320(1) Subject to subsections (2) to (6) and subsection 321(4), a council may by by-law

- a) approve the local improvement or special service as set out in the plan or proposal; and,
- b) authorize the municipality to impose taxes as set out in the plan or proposal.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of MacGregor has prepared Special Service Proposal No. 2011 -01 to establish a rate for police protection services within the Town of MacGregor as a special service pursuant to Part 10 of the Act;

AND WHEREAS the requirements as prescribed in section 318, 319 and 320 of the Act have been complied with;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of MacGregor enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** pursuant to Subsection 320(1) of the Act, the Town of MacGregor approves Special Service Proposal No. 2011-01 attached hereto as Schedule "A".
2. **THAT** the Town of MacGregor levy a Special Service Tax annually upon all residential, commercial and railway properties, excluding vacant lots as hereby attached in Schedule "B".
