## Additions to the Voters List and/or Personal Security Protection Requests

### Town of MacGregor Rural Municipality of North Norfolk

---

In accordance with Section 36 of The Municipal Councils and School Boards Election Act, the Voters Lists for the Town of MacGregor and the Rural Municipality of North Norfolk are open for changes or revisions.

- Any person who is eligible to vote in municipal elections in the Local Authority of the Town of MacGregor or the Rural Municipality of North Norfolk can have his or her name added to the appropriate Voters List, or have any information about the voter on the Voters List corrected.
- Any person can request to have his or her name and address obscured from the Voters List.
- A person whose name has been obscured will receive a Personal Security Certificate and identification number. In a civic election, that person may only vote by Sealed Envelope Ballot and cannot vote in person at the regular or advance voting places.

**MUNICIPAL AND SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS ACT  
MAINTAINING THE VOTERS LIST**

**Important reminder to all Chief Administrative Officers**

An accurate and up-to-date voters list is key to facilitating a smooth general election or a by-election.

*The Municipal Councils and School Boards Elections Act* requires **public notice be given annually** that any person may apply to have a name added, deleted, information changed or their name obscured from the list. It is recommended that the public notice be issued early in the year, prior to the end of March.

The public notice will remind voters that the list is a permanent document, to be continuously revised when any new voter information becomes available. Public notice may be given by:

- publishing the notice in a newspaper(s) having general circulation in the local authority; and/or
- mailing/distributing the notice to every household in the local authority.
